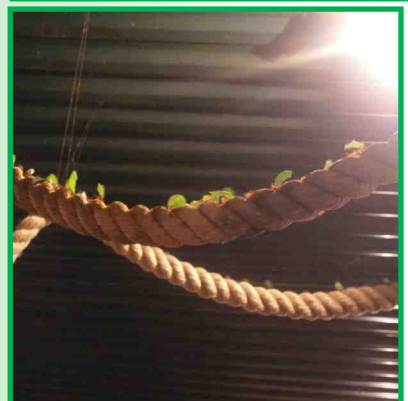


## Our trip to Birmingham City Centre...
