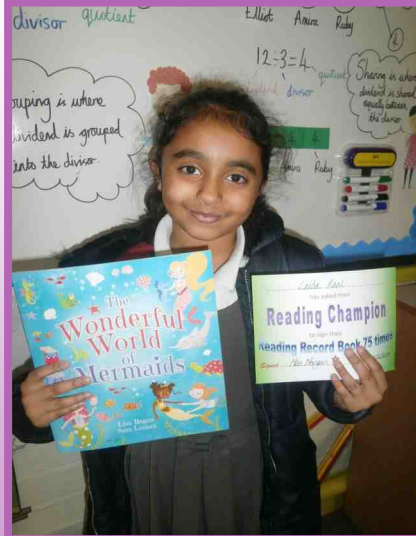


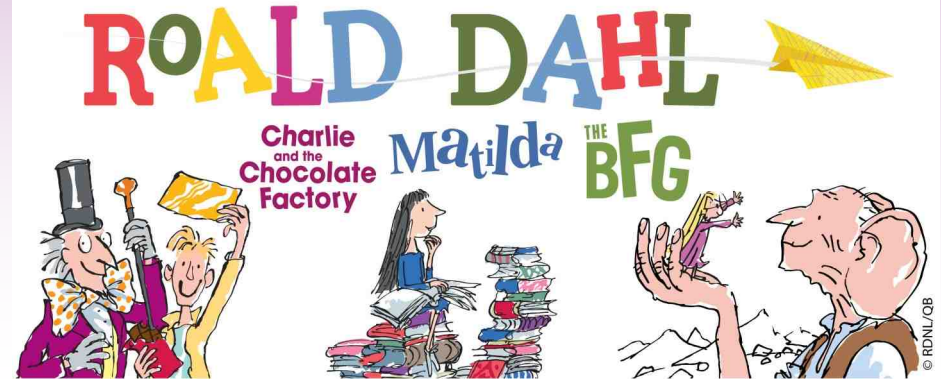
At the end of the term, three children won special governor awards. We are very proud of them and look forward to seeing who wins the awards next term.



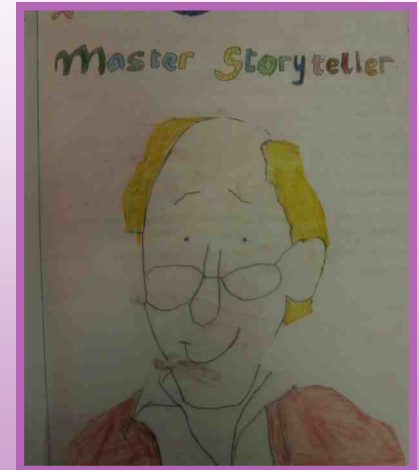
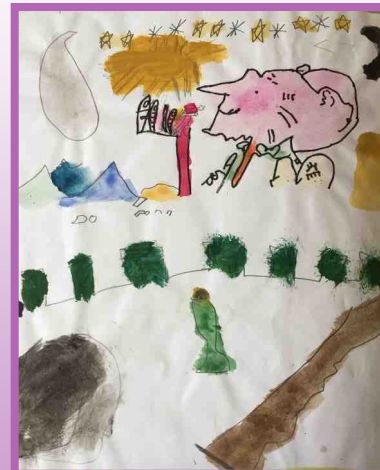

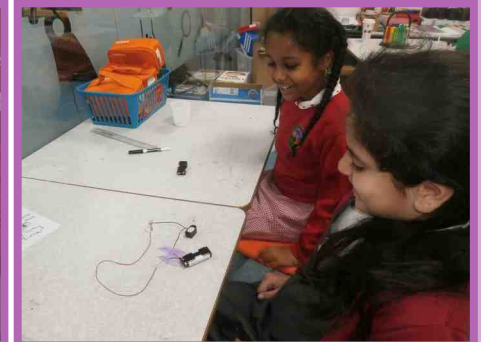
## Learning about the life of Roald Dahl...

This was to notify the farmers when Mr Fox was trying to steal the hens.

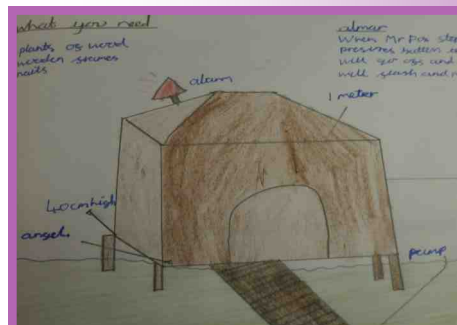
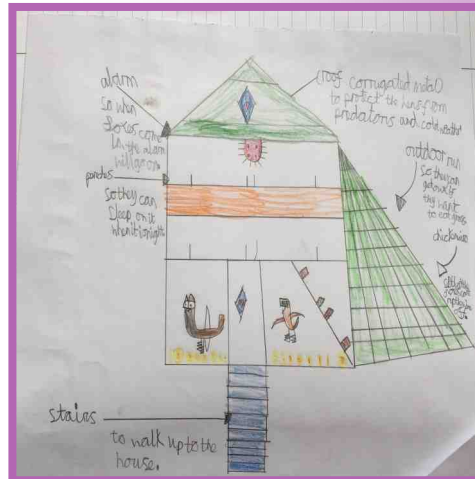
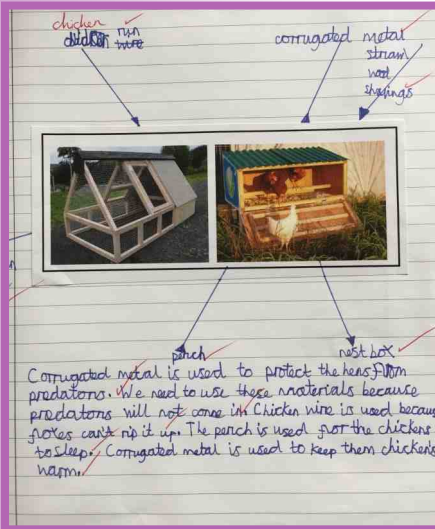


We made a circuit using a battery, wires, an alarm and a light.
