<u>Writing</u>

-To retell and write

stories with a beginning, middle and end.

- To use the conjunctions:

and, but, so and because, to vary sentences.

- To sound out words using their phonic knowledge.

<u>Science</u>

This half term we will learn about plants.



Homework

A **maths** activity will be given out on Friday linked to the learning happening in class. This should be returned by Monday of the following week.

Spelling— Every **Friday** the children will receive spelling homework. There will be 5 common exception words on the sheet which they will need to practise at home. They will

be tested every Friday on these words.

Reading—Children should be reading everyday. They will have a new reading book once a week.
