## **Our learning**

#### Maths

**Children will continue to practise** their arithmetic skills daily. This term we will cover measures,

statistics. co-ordinates as well as algebra with a focus on developing reasoning skills. The children will be given new reasoning books which they will use for homework, these should be brought back by Friday and marked in class.

Mathletics homework will be set weekly.

## Reading

This term we will focus on analysing shorter extracts with the aim of developing retrieval and inference skills. We will work on comprehension techniques ensuring answers are precise. **Reading daily will hugely support** your child's learning, please ensure your child is reading their home reader daily.
