Arriving to school/ collection of children

- Please wear a mask at all times when on the school grounds. Any children wearing masks to school will be asked to remove them before entering the school buildings.
- Do not wait around on the school grounds or gather to chat with other parents.
- The timings for the drop off and collection must be strictly adhered to.
- Please remember it should only be 1 parent/ carer on site with the children.
- Please remember that it is everyone's responsibility to maintain social distancing both inside and outside of the school's grounds.
- As you are aware, there is a one-way system on the playground that must be followed.
- Staff members are in the playground at the beginning and end of the school day to ensure the safety of children and yourselves.
- All families to stay within their own family bubble. Children to stand with their appropriate adult and not to run around playing with other children.
- Children must wear school uniform. Sensible school shoes must be worn at all times. Clothes should be washed regularly as normal.
- On their PE day, children should wear their PE kit to school. This should be joggers or leggings and a sweatshirt with trainers. Children should not wear jeans for PE.

Group A

- Children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 plus their brothers and sisters
- Please line up from the main gate down towards Couchman Road
- You can enter the school grounds from 8:30am
- The main school gate will not open until 8:30am
- You will not receive a late mark unless your child arrives after 9:00am
- At the end of the school day, the gate will open at 3:00pm

Group B

- Children only in years 3,4,5 and 6
- We encourage parents/ carers of children in group B to drop their children off at the gate rather than come onto the school grounds
- Please line up from the side gate up towards Bridge Road
- You will enter the school grounds through this gate from 8:45am
- The side gate will not open until 8:45am
- It is advisable that you do not approach the school until this time to avoid congestion
- Your child will not receive a late mark unless your child arrives after 9:00am
- At the end of the day, the gate will open at 3:15pm (12.15pm on Friday)
